



# Moving Checklist

Moving to a new house is a chaotic and often stressful time.

To help you on your way, we have created a moving checklist to ensure a seamless transition into your new home.



## Prior to the Settlement Day

- Schedule a removalist for the Settlement Day
- Organise Home and Contents Insurance for your new house
- Contact your electricity provider and arrange a final reading at your current house and connection at your new house
- Contact your phone and internet provider to arrange disconnection at your current house and reconnection at your new house
- Contact Australia Post to arrange redirection of your mail
- Contact any delivery service providers and advise your new address (i.e. meal subscriptions, newspaper etc)

## One Day Prior to Settlement Date

- Contact the Real Estate Agent to arrange a final inspection of your new house
- Advise your solicitor if there are any issues with the final inspection of your new house

## Settlement Day

- Return current house keys to Real Estate Agent (if applicable)
- Collect keys to new house from Real Estate Agent following settlement

## After Settlement

- Cancel your home and contents insurance at your previous address
- Update your address with government agencies and service providers, including:
  - Medicare
  - Australian Electoral Commission
  - Australian Taxation Office
  - Department of Transport and Main Roads
  - Your bank
  - Your children's school or childcare centre (if applicable)
- Update your Will and Power of Attorney
